



Sport In Colleges

Key Facts | 2017/18

80% of colleges in England are AoC Sport members




11,748 students represented their colleges in AoC Sport regional tournaments in 2016/17



Within Sport, Leisure & Recreation there are 54,530 EFA funded learners (16-18). This equates to 8% of all EFA funded learners



Colleges deliver 359 qualifications within Sport, Leisure & Recreation up to level 3 & 146 at level 4 & above




Within Sport, Leisure and Recreation there are 800 under 16s, 65,780 aged 16-19, 7,540 aged 20-23 and 30,320 aged 24 & above



There are more than 550,000 people employed in sport and leisure



82% of students agree sport improves mental well-being. The average college has 185 students with disclosed mental health conditions



More than 50% of students say taking part in sport helps with college work & almost half say involvement in sport helped develop employability skills




College leavers who took part in sport have a higher annual household income (£35,464) than those who did not (£28,808), a difference of £6,656

Colleges organise an average of 676 sport and physical activity sessions and events per year
